Causes: Illegal logging, weak law enforcement.

Consequences: Loss of biodiversity, increased floods, carbon emissions.

Sources: Industrial waste, agriculture runoff, urban sewage.

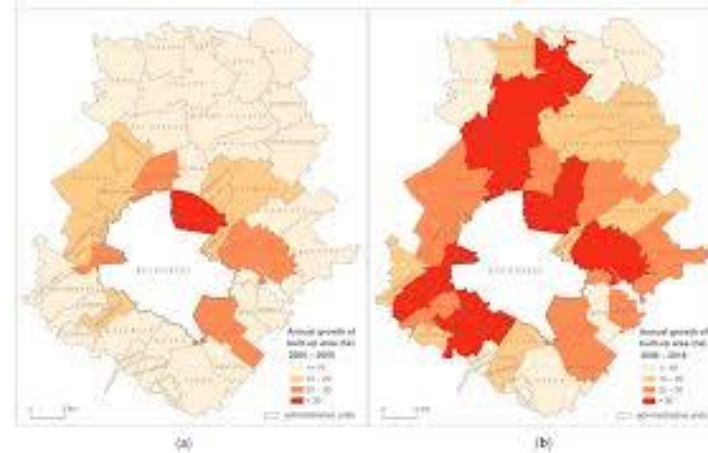
Major Rivers: Danube, Argeş, Olt.

Causes: Post-1989 economic shift, poor planning.
